## Did You Know...?

- Every 17 minutes a person dies by suicide; 86 people take their own life each day; and another 1,500 attempt suicide in the United States.
- More than 1,000 Illinoisans die each year by suicide, which exceeds the number of deaths from homicide, HIV/AIDS or deaths by impaired driving.
- Approximately 6 immediate family members and close friends are dramatically affected by each suicide death.
- Suicide rotates between the second and third leading cause of death for adolescents in Illinois.

## Suicidal Signs and Behaviors:

- **Symptoms** of depression.
- Expressions of hopelessness, helplessness and desperation.
- Increased alcohol and substance use.
- Expressing no reason for living; no sense of purpose in life
- Statements revealing a desire to die.
